Chief Financial Officer

Primary Objective of Position:

To manage and direct ARRL operations relating to personnel policies, financial functions, purchasing and administrative services, and the development office.

Accountability:

The Chief Financial Officer is accountable to the Chief Executive Officer.

Major Areas of Responsibility:

- 1. Employs and directs Headquarters staff and maintains performance standards in those Headquarters operations listed above.
- 2. With the Chief Executive Officer, drafts budget plans and manages operations by approved plans.
- 3. Collects monies due ARRL and deposits; delivers surplus funds to the Treasurer for investment.
- 4. Verifies and pays bills owed by ARRL.
- 5. Draws and counter-signs checks.
- 6. Maintains the financial records of ARRL and prepares financial reports for the Chief Executive Officer, Board of Directors, and the Administration & Finance Committee as requested.
- 7. Is in charge of all property of ARRL.
- 8. Performs other such duties as the Chief Executive Officer may assign.
