HF Contest Log Deadlines Extended to 7 Days

For the 2017 – 2018 contest season, ARRL HF contest log deadlines were reduced to 5 days after the event. This significantly enhanced our ability to release event results in a timely fashion. However, some participant feedback suggested having a subsequent full weekend (7 days after an event) to complete log reviews and web upload submission would be helpful. For the coming contest season, we will extend the HF log deadlines to 7 days following the end of the event.

Club Competition

The new toolset for clubs to comply with the Club Competition rules (as announced in 2016) has been fully implemented. Automations now report eligibility based on club member call/grid inclusion in the club eligibility lists and based on club members' locations within club territories.

New Contest Landing Page on ARRL Web

To give ARRL contest participants the ability to access all post-event information and tools from one page, we are completing development of an ARRL Contest Branch one-stop web page. From there, participants will be able to easily access things like the log uploader, logs received confirmations, log-checking reports, online certificates, contest results/ articles, club eligibility files, and more. Electronic Log Formats for ARRL 10 GHz & Up Contest/ARRL International EME Contest

We are currently testing ARRL's contest log web uploader for events that have not had Cabrillo options previously, like the ARRL International EME Contest and the 10 GHz & Up Contest.
